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MR. BRAUN: We will open the I guess
we can open the Local Development Corporation
meeting. It is Wednesday, October 20th. It
is now 9:13. A quorum is present and I will
pause for a minute till Lisa comes back as she
addresses our technical problem.
MS. LINSE: Fred.
(Pause.)
MS. MULLIGAN: I apologize. Bill was
having some issues joining us, we're trying to
figure out what's going on.
Where's my blurb?
(Pause.)
MS. MULLIGAN: I apologize.
This meeting is being conducted
electronically via Zoom in accordance with
Part E of Chapter 417 of the laws of 2021
which amended the New York Open Meetings Law
to allow for electronic meetings due to
COVID-19.
MR. BRAUN: Okay.
Lori, we'll turn it over to you for the
budget discussion.

MS. MULLIGAN: And Lori, I'm going to

1 2 share my screen. 3 MS. LaPONTE: Okay. So the first report we're going to do 4 5 is the August comparison. 6 It's saying my Internet connection is 7 unstable; can you hear me? 8 MS. MULLIGAN: We can hear you. 9 MR. CALLAHAN: We got you. 10 MS. LaPONTE: Okay, good. 11 I'm right in the office but . . . 12 MS. MULLIGAN: August --13 MR. WEIR: Lisa, before you --14 MS. MULLIGAN: Hi, Bill. 15 MR. WEIR: I am on. I could not join 16 by computer, our help desk said your link was 17 corrupted. I don't know if anybody else had 18 trouble getting in, but it was blocked by our 19 network. 20 MR. CALLAHAN: Maybe that's why we're

MR. CALLAHAN: Maybe that's why we're having problems.

MS. MULLIGAN: Might be.

MR. WEIR: Yeah. There's something
wrong with -- they kept saying it did not look
like a normal Zoom link and so our security

2	people could not get in, so I don't know what
3	happened, but it's not the correct link.
4	So are other people having so before
5	we start the meeting, here's a procedural
6	question, are other people having a hard time
7	getting into this meeting?
8	MR. GROSS: I had to get in a different
9	way than ever before. Before I simply just
10	clicked things and it was pretty simple. This
11	time I had to put in a meeting identifier and
12	then a passcode.
13	MR. WEIR: So here's my concern: if
1 4	we're having trouble getting in, are there
15	members of the public who can't get in and
16	therefore, this meeting is not valid?
17	MS. MULLIGAN: I see people
18	MS. LINSE: There's other people
19	MS. MULLIGAN: There's other people
2 0	MR. WEIR: Only one person at a time
21	talking.
22	MS. MULLIGAN: This is Lisa.
23	MR. WEIR: Go ahead, Lisa.
2 4	MS. MULLIGAN: Peter Curry, Michael
2.5	from Todd's office, they're in the waiting

2	room right now, so I think that it's you
3	know, I don't know if other people are trying
4	to get in, but people are able to join. I
5	don't know if it's difficult, but
6	MR. GRUCCI: Well, didn't Jim say he
7	got kicked off a couple of times?
8	MS. SCHEIDT: He's muted.
9	MS. MULLIGAN: But he's nodding.
10	MR. TULLO: I did, but then once I
11	clicked on it a second time, it allowed me
12	back in, but initially it went the screen
13	spun and it had me reenter everything to get
14	back in similar to Howard.
15	MS. MULLIGAN: We've been having some
16	Internet issue in the office, so what about
17	everybody I know Howard had some issues;
18	what about people who are out of this
19	building? I see Steve Ripp just joined.
20	MR. CALLAHAN: No problems on my end.
21	MS. SCHEIDT: No, none on my mine.
22	MR. GRUCCI: I didn't have any
23	problems, either.
24	MS. MULLIGAN: Bill, we do have three
25	people from the public, you know, I expected

And I just got an email from Peter

saying he can hear and see everything.

He's in the waiting room.

Thank you, Peter.

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2	MR. CALLAHAN: I got that, too.
3	MR. GRUCCI: Bill, since this meeting
4	is also being recorded, would it still be
5	valid if somebody couldn't get in, but got the
6	ability to see and hear the meeting at a
7	different date?
8	MR. WEIR: Um I have to think
9	about that.
10	MR. GRUCCI: Okay.
11	MS. LaPONTE: Okay.
12	I'm going to go onto the report that I
13	shared with everyone.
14	MS. MULLIGAN: Lori, you can do August
15	quick since we have September, too.
16	MS. LaPONTE: Okay.
17	So during the month of August,
18	basically in the LDC there was very little
19	activity. The activity in the expense column
20	is a culmination of catching up year-to-date
21	costs on the cost allocation between the IDA
22	and the LDC.
23	Overall for the eight months ended,
24	we're at a net loss of 50,000, which is based
25	on a pro rata share of the budget; we're

2	actually ahead of budget by 20,000.
3	Is any questions on the LDC August
4	report, profit and loss versus budget?
5	MR. GRUCCI: Are we expecting any
6	income in the next four months for the LDC?
7	MS. MULLIGAN: No. I don't expect
8	anything significant for the LDC except for we
9	are going to be doing our annual admin fees in
10	the next couple of months, so there's that,
11	you know, 5,000 or so that you see
12	MS. LaPONTE: We already got it.
13	MS. MULLIGAN: I'm sorry, that's for
1 4	next year, next year, so
15	MS. LaPONTE: Other than interest
16	income, there's really nothing on the horizon.
17	MS. MULLIGAN: We have no projects.
18	I guess it's possible that something
19	could just appear and if that were the case,
20	then we would have an application fee, but
21	that's the most that I expect.
22	MS. LaPONTE: Any other questions on
23	August?

24 (No response.) ${\tt MS.}$ ${\tt MULLIGAN:}$ ${\tt Do}$ you want me to switch 25

2	it?
3	MR. BRAUN: No, we'll accept both at
4	the same time.
5	MS. LaPONTE: Oh, okay.
6	We're going to go onto the next report
7	in the package is September year to date
8	actual versus budget for the LDC for the month
9	of September as mentioned.
10	I wanted to as it's coming up on the
11	screen, there was no activity as far as
12	revenue, a small amount of interest and pretty

I wanted to -- as it's coming up on the screen, there was no activity as far as revenue, a small amount of interest and pretty much the only thing that you'll see is in the expenses is we pay all of our insurance for the LDC, the policies are in September, so that's why there's a little change for that month.

Again, year to date, we're at a net loss of about 67,000, but overall we're still expected for a net loss for the year, but we're a little bit below of what our expectations were.

Are there any questions on the LDC budget versus actual for the month of September year to date, also?

2	MR. CALLAHAN: So our budgeting has
3	been working well?
4	MS. LaPONTE: Yes.
5	MR. BRAUN: If there are no questions,
6	I'll entertain a motion to accept Lori's
7	report for both August and September.
8	MR. GRUCCI: So moved.
9	MS. SCHEIDT: Second.
10	MR. BRAUN: Thank you.
11	On the vote, Mr. Callahan?
12	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
13	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Grucci?
14	MR. GRUCCI: Yes.
15	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Paprocky?
16	MS. PAPROCKY: Yes.
17	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt?
18	MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.
19	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Braun votes yes.
20	Both reports have been accepted.
21	MS. LaPONTE: The next item that's in
22	the package is actually the budget, PARIS
23	budget report and it's for we'll show the
24	budget that we presented last month, it
25	remains unchanged, but this is in PARIS and

2	you have to project it out for the next couple
3	of years, so I'm just trying to see, if
4	you need to see which report I'm talking
5	about, I'm just going to pull it up and that's
6	not it.
7	MR. BRAUN: And this has to be filed
8	November 1st?
9	MS. LaPONTE: Yes, November 1st.
10	I'm actually going to show it to you
11	only because Lisa stepped away
12	MS. MULLIGAN: I'm right here.
13	MS. LaPONTE: I'm sorry.
14	MR. CALLAHAN: It's in the packet,
15	isn't it?
16	MS. MULLIGAN: It is, it is. I'm just
17	going to share, just give me one second.
18	MS. LaPONTE: That's it. Okay.
19	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay, hold on.
20	MS. LaPONTE: There we go, perfect;
21	thank you, Lisa.
22	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay.
23	You guys can see that?
24	MR. GRUCCI: Yes, ma'am.
25	MS. MULLIGAN: Excellent. All right.

2	MS. LaPONTE: Included in the package
3	is the PARIS, this is a draft, it's been
4	unsubmitted, but it's due, as Fred mentioned,
5	November 1st and it shows our budget for the
6	next couple of years, it shows our last year
7	actual audited results, our current year
8	budget and it's the budget we presented at the
9	last meeting and also, our projection of it
10	for the future, so that is also presented in
11	the package.
12	Is there any questions on that budget?
13	(No response.)
14	MR. BRAUN: We need a motion to accept
15	the budget and the authorization to file it
16	under PARIS.
17	MR. GRUCCI: So moved.
18	MR. BRAUN: Thank you, Felix.
19	Is there a second?
20	MR. CALLAHAN: Second.
21	MR. BRAUN: On the vote, Mr. Callahan?
22	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
23	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Grucci?
24	MR. GRUCCI: Yes.
25	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Paprocky?

1 2. MS. PAPROCKY: Yes. 3 MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt? MS. SCHEIDT: Yes. 4 5 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Braun votes yes. 6 The budget is approved and authorized 7 to file. MR. GRUCCI: I know this is after the 9 fact, but, Lori, we don't show any revenue 10 other than the administrative fees going 11 forward for the next several years? MS. LaPONTE: Yes. And that's based on 12 13 what we know is in the hopper or what we think 14 is coming. 15 So in the past, we've shown this type 16

of budget similarly for LDC until we knew there were those two projects up and coming, which we usually have a rough idea about a year or two before, but at this point, we're not going to project anything because of our history of not many projects.

MR. GRUCCI: Okay. 22

23 MS. LaPONTE: Any other questions on

24 the budget for PARIS?

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25 (No response.)

2	MS. LaPONTE: The last thing I want to
3	mention is timely payments and I'm going to be
4	discussing this as part of my presentation at
5	all meetings, it's one of the things that Fred
6	had discussed with us, that all legal and
7	contractual payments for the LDC as of 9/30
8	have been met in accordance with the
9	requirements.
10	MR. BRAUN: Really focusing on the fact
11	that the LDC now has employees.
12	MS. LaPONTE: Right, exactly.
13	MR. BRAUN: And had we had PILOT
14	payments, they would have been distributed
15	within 30 days, although I don't think that
16	applies to the LDC anyway.
17	MS. LaPONTE: Right. Okay.
18	MR. BRAUN: Lisa, do you have any
19	anything else?
20	MS. MULLIGAN: No, that's all.
21	MR. BRAUN: Lori?
22	MS. MULLIGAN: Does anybody have any
23	questions?
24	(No response.)
25	MR. BRAUN: Need a motion to adjourn

On the vote, Mr. Callahan?

MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.

MR. BRAUN: Mr. Grucci?

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2	MR. GRUCCI: Yes.
3	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Paprocky?
