1	MR. BRAUN: This is 9:03. It is
2	Wednesday, March 16th. This is a meeting of
3	the Audit Committee for the Town of
4	Brookhaven Local Development Corporation.
5	The following directors are present,
6	Mr. Grucci, Mr. Pollakusky, Mrs. Scheidt, Mr.
7	Trotta, Mr. Braun. We do have a quorum.
8	Lisa?
9	MS. MULLIGAN: Today's meeting has been
10	convened in accordance with Chapter 417 of
11	the Laws of 2021 effective September 2021
12	through sorry, through today, thank you,
13	permitting local governments to hold public
14	meetings by telephone and videoconference.
15	MR. BRAUN: Thank you. Lori, I'll turn
16	it over to you to introduce our friend from
17	PKF.
18	MS. MULLIGAN: Lor, you're muted.
19	MS. LAPONTE: That sounded so good.
20	I'd like to introduce everybody to the
21	partners from PKF O'Connor Davies. We have
22	Jeff Davoli and also Brian Petersen. This is
23	our rotation year, so every five years we
24	have another partner step in.
25	So we have both partners, so we got two

1 for the price of one this year. MS. MULLIGAN: Should we bring Octavio 2 and Beth in? 3 MS. LINSE: I'm trying to. It's not 4 5 letting me so far. MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. 6 7 MS. LAPONTE: Okay, so as Lisa mentioned, Octavio Chacon, Beth Casey, Beth 8 9 is manager on our account, has been since 10 we've been with PKF O'Connor Davies, and so 11 Octavio Chacon is a supervising senior from 12 PKF O'Connor Davies. They are also on the --13 in the room, as attendees. 14 MS. MULLIGAN: For some reason, we're 15 not able to bring them in, so I don't know. 16 I apologize. 17 MR. DAVOLI: No worries. Good morning, 18 everyone. My name is Jeff Davoli, audit 19 partner of PKFOD, and as Lori stated, this is 20 a rotation year, so under the P AAA Rules, 21 Brian Petersen, my partner, with over 15 22 years of experience in municipalities, school 23 districts and public authorities took over 24 the audit this year, so I know there's a busy 25 agenda ahead of you folks, so I understand,

1 our comments will be brief and to the point. 2 So, Brian? 3 MR. PETERSEN: So good morning, 4 everybody. Thank you for your time today. 5 So, first I'd like to thank Fred, Lori, Lisa, 6 and the staff of the LDC for their assistance 7 in completing the audit timely and effectively. 8 9 We had prepared our draft opinions for 10 the LDC's financial statements for the year 11 ended December 31st of 2021, and we are happy 12 to report that the reports received an 13 unmodified or a clean opinion. 14 Management is responsible for the 15 selection and use of the appropriate 16 accounting policies. The significant 17 accounting policies of the LDC are described 18 in Note A to the respective financial 19 statements. We're happy to report that the 20 LDC had no changes in their accounting 21 policies during the year. 22 We encountered no difficulties in 23 dealing with management during the audit. 24 There was also no disagreements with 25 management as well. Accounting estimates

1 made by management are an integral part of the financial statements and are based on 2 management's knowledge and experience about 3 4 past and current events and assumptions about 5 future events. The actual results could differ from 6 7 those estimates. There were no significant estimates in the LDC's financial statements. 8 9 Professional standards require us to 10 accumulate all known and likely mis-11 statements identified during the audit, other 12 than those that we believe to be trivial and 13 communicate them to the appropriate level of 14 management. So we are required to 15 communicate to you mis-statements that remain 16 uncorrected, including any related to prior periods and the effect, if any, on our report 17 18 and request their correction. 19 I'm happy to report as well, that there 20 were no such mis-statements noted this year. 21 Additional reports that we will be 22 issuing are -- is the report on internal 23 control over financial reporting and our 24 compliance and other matters based on our 25 audit of financial statements performed in

2	standards, and we will also be issuing our
3	independent auditor's report on investment
4	compliance.
5	I'm happy to report that the results of
6	our test resulted in no deficiencies and no
7	non-compliance with laws and regulations were
8	noted.
9	It is important to note that we have no
10	management comments as well this year, which
11	is an indication of the quality of the
12	management and staff of the LDC and the IDA.
13	Once we get clearance from the
14	committee, we will be able to move forward to
15	finalization process of the financial
16	statements. I want to ask the Committee if
17	they have any questions for the LDC financial
18	statements for Jeff and I?
19	MS. MULLIGAN: Sorry, you were muted.
20	MR. BRAUN: Questions from the board?
21	MR. TROTTA: No.
22	MS. MULLIGAN: The audit was sent in
23	your packet, just if there's any specifics.
24	MR. BRAUN: I just again want to point
25	out as he did, that they reviewed our system
l	

1 for internal controls, and no comments there 2 either. 3 If there are no questions or other 4 comments, I need a motion to accept this 5 report and also as a recommendation to the 6 Board in our meeting later on today. 7 Remembering, also, that this report needs to 8 be filed with our PARIS reports by March 9 31st, may I have a motion, please? 10 MR. TROTTA: Motion. 11 MR. BRAUN: Thank you. 12 MS. SCHEIDT: Second. 13 MR. BRAUN: On the vote. Mr. Grucci? 14 MR. GRUCCI: Yes. 15 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Pollakusky? 16 MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes. 17 MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt? 18 MS. SCHEIDT: Yes. 19 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta? 20 MR. TROTTA: Yes. 21 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Braun votes yes. The 22 motion carried. 23 MS. MULLIGAN: Just for the record and 24 for the stenographer, that was Mr. Trotta who 25 made the motion and Ms. Scheidt who seconded

1 it. 2 MR. BRAUN: If there are no further questions, I'll entertain a motion to adjourn 3 4 the meeting of the Local Development 5 Corporation. 6 MS. MULLIGAN: Audit Committee. 7 MR. GRUCCI: So moved. 8 MS. SCHEIDT: So moved. Second to 9 Felix. 10 MS. MULLIGAN: Thank you, Ann-Marie. 11 MR. BRAUN: On the vote. Mr. Grucci? 12 MR. GRUCCI: Yes. 13 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Pollakusky? 14 MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes. 15 MR. BRAUN: Mrs. Scheidt? 16 MS. SCHEIDT: Yes. 17 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta? 18 MR. TROTTA: Yes. 19 MR.
