4	the Finance Committee of the Local Development
5	Corporation and I will turn it over to Lisa
6	and Lori to discuss a couple of things. As it
7	relates to concepts, this is not well, let
8	me back up a minute.
9	I would like a motion to go into
10	executive session to discuss a matter of
11	personnel.
12	MR. TROTTA: Motion.
13	MR. GRUCCI: So moved.
14	MS. MULLIGAN: Is Bill on?
15	MR. WEIR: I am on.
16	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. So I guess now as
17	crazy as this is, we have to drop out of this
18	and go into the executive session Zoom.
19	Should we talk about the other items
20	while we're in here?
21	MR. BRAUN: Sure.
22	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay.
23	MR. WEIR: Talk about the other items,
24	then go into executive session.
25	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. Okay.

Ζ	so on your agenda, you'll see that we
3	have two items listed, it's amended budget and
4	cost sharing and so what we are proposing and
5	as Fred pointed out, this is sort of a
6	conceptual discussion. We don't have an
7	amended budget ready for you to review because
8	we want to make sure that you are
9	understand and agree with the route that we're
10	proposing, so I'm going to skip over amended
11	budget just for one second and move onto cost
12	sharing.
13	The LDC historically has not really
14	paid its fair share of expenses and last year
15	there were two closings. For the first time
16	we have some money and we think that it's
17	about time that the LDC start picking up
18	the a proportionate share of some of the
19	expenses; you know, off the top of my head:
20	marketing, rent, phone, cable, office
21	supplies.
22	Lori?
23	(No response.)
24	MS. MULLIGAN: You're muted.

MS. LaPONTE: Yes. Those were the

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2	ıtems	that	wе	identified.

MS. MULLIGAN: So we're still work -obviously since we don't have an amended
budget, we're still working on what the
proportion should be if -- you know, I think
some things like marketing probably should be
a 50/50 split, but this is the type of stuff
that we have to sort of work through and
figure out, but we didn't really want to work
through it and figure it out if the board
members weren't on the same page.

MR. BRAUN: We can't really do it on a square footage basis because the LDC and the IDA operate next to each other, as one almost. We probably can't do it on a percentage of deals because the LDC has about six deals where the IDA's into the 80's, so we'd be talking a small percentage, but as Lisa said, there are some items; advertising some of the public events we could probably split 50/50. I suspect that we will come back to you in May to approve an amended LDC budget where the LDC will probably pick up 20 to 25 percent of the items or those categories that Lisa and Lori

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2	are talking about.
3	MR. GRUCCI: Fred, is this a function
4	of being in compliance with regulations or is
5	this just an internal concept for us to make
6	fair as best we can the two entities?
7	MR. BRAUN: It's not regulatory, it's
8	conceptual and something we may have done
9	before. I think it's kind of highlighted a
10	little bit once the Town eliminated the
11	Department of Economic Development and
12	everything fell back into the IDA.
13	MR. GRUCCI: Okay.
14	Is labor and benefits part of those
15	calculations?
16	MR. BRAUN: We're going to get to that
17	in executive session in a minute.
18	MR. GRUCCI: Got you.
19	MR. BRAUN: Any questions?
20	(No response.)

15	that way maybe there could be like, I don't
16	know, a quarterly transfer just to keep things
17	clean and also, obviously we'll work with our
18	auditors to make sure that they're okay with
19	that approach.
