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2 MR. BRAUN: We'll start with the Local 3 Development Corporation. This is Wednesday, October 21st. I should tell you that once 4 5 that meeting is concluded, we will open the 6 IDA meeting, it's likely we'll go into 7 executive session in the middle of that 8 meeting and then come back into the Zoom later 9 on, but to the Local Development Corporation, 10 directors that are on the call are Gary 11 Pollakusky, Ann-Marie Scheidt, Frank Trotta, 12 Marty Callahan and Fred Braun. We still 13 expect Felix Grucci, although he has not 14 signed on yet. 15 MS. MULLIGAN: We also need to open the 16 budget committee meeting at the same time. 17 MR. BRAUN: This is also a meeting of 18 the budget committee for the 2021 budget. 19 The minutes of our meeting of 20 September 16th have been sent to everyone. 21 Can I have a motion to accept? 22 MR. TROTTA: Motion. 23 MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved. 24 MR. BRAUN: Are there any 25 clarifications, comments, corrections?

3	MR. BRAUN: Hearing none, all those in
4	favor?
5	I should call the roll differently.
6	Mr. Pollakusky?
7	MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes, aye.
8	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt?
9	MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.
10	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta?
11	MR. TROTTA: Yes.
12	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan?
13	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
14	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Braun votes yes.
15	Similarly the minutes of our
16	October 7th meeting have been sent.
17	A motion to accept those, please.
18	MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved.
19	MS. SCHEIDT: Second.
20	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Pollakusky?
21	MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes.
22	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt?
23	MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.
24	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta?
25	MR. TROTTA: Yes.

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2	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan?
3	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
4	MR. BRAUN: And Mr. Braun votes yes.
5	Thank you.
6	Lori, I'll turn it over to you.
7	MS. LaPONTE: Included in the packages
8	are the operating reports for the month of
9	September and August, I just want to go
10	through.
11	During the month of August, there is
12	relatively little activity, it's just our
13	recurring insurance payments, some legal
14	publications and our website maintenance, that
15	was the August report that's in the package
16	and then in September, similarly, we just had
17	bank interest and also our website
18	maintenance.
19	That's the operating report for the
20	LDC.
21	Is there any questions?
22	(No response.)
23	MR. BRAUN: A motion to accept the
24	report.
25	MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved.

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2	MS. SCHEIDT: Second.
3	MR. BRAUN: On the vote,
4	Mr. Pollakusky?
5	MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes.
6	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt?
7	MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.
8	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta?
9	MR. TROTTA: Yes.
10	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan?
11	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
12	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Braun votes yes.
13	The 2021 budget is due to the ABO by
14	November 1st.
15	Lori.
16	MS. LaPONTE: Yes.
17	So included in the package is the
18	budget for the Local Development Corporation.
19	We estimate there will be a closing in 2021,
20	there will be one closing. Our admin fees are
21	pretty much consistent, they're flat from year
22	to year, it's based on the number of projects.
23	Interest income has been tweaked a
24	little for the change in the rates and then
25	the other expenditures are pretty much our

2 miscellaneous office items, legal, stationery, 3 pads, stuff like that. There's also a fee for our annual audit and our insurance, so it's a 4 5 net positive budget of 102,000 for 2021. 6 MR. BRAUN: Any questions from the 7 board? 8 (No response.) 9 MR. BRAUN: Hearing none, I'll 10 entertain a motion to accept the budget for 11 2021. 12 MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved. MS. SCHEIDT: Second. 13 14 MR. BRAUN: On the vote, 15 Mr. Pollakusky? 16 MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes. 17 MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt? 18 MS. SCHEIDT: Yes. 19 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta? 20 MR. TROTTA: Yes. 21 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan? 22 MR. CALLAHAN: Yes. 23 MR. BRAUN: And Mr. Braun votes yes. 24 Thank you. 25 Lisa, do we have one resolution?

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2	MS. MULLIGAN: We do.
3	So someone just joined the meeting.
4	Sir, would you just state your name for
5	the record and your affiliation?
6	MR. DIOLOSA: Paul Diolosa, I'm with
7	American Regent.
8	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay. Thank you for
9	joining.
10	The only resolution on our agenda is
11	for Active Retirement Community, Inc. doing
12	business as Jefferson's Ferry.
13	We held a public hearing this
14	morning I'm sorry, yesterday; there was no
15	comment.
16	Bill, do you want to give a quick
17	overview?
18	(No response.)
19	MS. MULLIGAN: Bill, you're on mute.
20	MR. WEIR: Sorry about that.
21	We held a supplemental public notice to
22	include in the public notice some additional
23	capital expenditures that are being incurred
24	by Jefferson's Ferry and also reimbursing them
25	for capital expenditures they've already

2 incurred to date. It's the same project, no
3 real change to it.

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We actually mailed the official statement last week for this project. It looks like we may be pricing just before the end of October with a closing expected to happen on or about November 10th, so this will be the LDC's second bond deal closing within two weeks of each other.

Long Island Community Hospital is expected to price today or tomorrow on those bonds and close next week, so LDC, you'll see by the November board meeting a substantial increase in the LDC's income for the month of October and November.

MR. BRAUN: Bill, I don't have theresolution in front of me.

19 The maximum amount on that?

20 MR. WEIR: I don't have it in front of 21 me, either.

Lisa, do you have it, I apologize?
MS. MULLIGAN: It's okay, I can get it.
Joce, do you have it, I think it's
probably . . .

2 MS. LINSE: I should, give me one 3 second. MR. WEIR: The trouble with Zoom is I 4 5 can't get back into my computer and listen to 6 you guys. 7 (Pause.) 8 MS. MULLIGAN: If it will open, slowly. 9 (Pause.) 10 MS. MULLIGAN: A hundred million not to exceed 125 million. 11 12 MR. WEIR: Thank you, Lisa. 13 MS. MULLIGAN: No problem. MR. BRAUN: I'll entertain a motion to 14 15 approve that resolution for Active Retirement 16 Community doing business as Jefferson's Ferry. 17 MR. TROTTA: Motion. 18 MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved. 19 MR. CALLAHAN: Hey, Fred. 20 MR. BRAUN: Yes. 21 MR. CALLAHAN: I got a question. 22 Last week my father was put into 23 Jefferson's Ferry, so I want to know, am I 24 able to vote on this or recuse myself? 25 MR. BRAUN: Unless the attorneys say

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different, I don't think so, he's a patient. 2 3 MR. CALLAHAN: And I'm paying full boat, so I'm just . . . 4 5 MR. WEIR: Well, technically it's your 6 father paying, so I don't think you have a --7 MR. CALLAHAN: That's right. 8 MR. WEIR: And in full disclosure, both 9 of my parents were at Jefferson's Ferry for a 10 number of years. MR. CALLAHAN: Bill, just making sure 11 12 that it didn't come back to bite me. Not a 13 problem. MR. BRAUN: Okay. On the vote --14 15 MR. WEIR: If you were living there 16 Marty, you know, I mean seriously, if you were 17 living in the independent living units, then 18 it could be an issue, but . . . 19 MR. CALLAHAN: Okay. All right. Thank 20 you. 21 MR. BRAUN: On the vote, 22 Mr. Pollakusky? 23 MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes. 24 MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt? 25 MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.

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2	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta?
3	MR. TROTTA: Yes.
4	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan?
5	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
6	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Grucci?
7	MR. GRUCCI: I'm sorry, I just joined
8	on; what's the vote on?
9	MR. BRAUN: I wouldn't worry about it
10	then, we have enough to pass. It's on
11	Jefferson's Ferry.
12	MR. GRUCCI: Okay. I'm sorry about
13	that.
14	MR. BRAUN: Okay.
15	And Mr. Braun votes yes. The motion
16	carries.
17	Lisa, is there any other business to be
18	brought before the LDC?
19	MS. MULLIGAN: No.
20	MS. LaPONTE: I wanted to mention,
21	Fred, two items.
22	MR. BRAUN: Sure.
23	MS. LaPONTE: The Empire Bank is
24	merging probably in the next week, not
25	probably, we received notification with

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Flushing Federal.

3 Our current resolution talks about that we are approved to do business with Empire 4 5 National Bank or its successors or assignees, 6 so we're okay on that and I also wanted to 7 mention that our external auditors merged with 8 another firm, a larger firm, upstate, PKF, so 9 just making you aware of both of those items. 10 MR. BRAUN: Any questions from the board on either one of those? 11 12 (No response.) MR. BRAUN: Hearing none and with no 13 further business, I'll entertain a motion 14 15 to --16 MS. MULLIGAN: I'm sorry. 17 Before you do that, T. Shultzaberger, 18 are you here for the LDC meeting or the IDA 19 board meeting? 20 MR. SHULTZABERGER: The IDA meeting. 21 MS. MULLIGAN: Will you just tell us 22 your affiliation? 23 MR. SHULTZABERGER: I'm with American 24 Regent. We're putting in an application. 25 MS. MULLIGAN: Okay, great. Thank you.

2 We'll be right to your project. 3 MR. SHULTZABERGER: Okay. MR. BRAUN: And a motion to adjourn the 4 5 meeting, please. 6 MR. POLLAKUSKY: So moved. MR. TROTTA: Second. 7 8 MR. BRAUN: On the vote, Mr. Grucci? 9 (No response.) 10 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Pollakusky? MR. POLLAKUSKY: Yes. 11 MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt? 12 MS. SCHEIDT: Yes. 13 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta? 14 MR. TROTTA: Yes. 15 16 MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan? 17 MR. CALLAHAN: Yes. 18 MR. BRAUN: And Mr. Braun votes yes. 19 We'll go back to Mr. Grucci. MR. GRUCCI: Yes. 20 21 MR. BRAUN: Thank you. 22 MR. GRUCCI: I needed to shut the T.V. 23 off. 24 MS. MULLIGAN: And a vote to close the 25 finance committee, also.

8	MR. BRAUN: Ms. Scheidt?
9	MS. SCHEIDT: Yes.
10	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Trotta?
11	MR. TROTTA: Yes.
12	MR. BRAUN: Mr. Callahan?
13	MR. CALLAHAN: Yes.
