So PARIS has multi-screens and
multi-reporting. There's four reports that
are due for the 12/31 period.

What I did was just for keeping the number of documents down, I combined three of the reports into one thing, I think I called it CIP, so I'll review that section now.

It is -- the first page is our certified financial audit, so we're just referring that we're attesting to the certified financial audit. The next page is our investment report. That also is part of our audit, so we refer to that and the last page is our procurement transactions. So that's the one section of PARIS that we're ready to submit right now.

I'll go on to the next section, is the annual report and this is for the LDC, it goes through -- there's 12 subsections within the annual report, they've made this a lot of -- multifaceted.

2	So the first couple of pages are
3	governance about the board and then we go into
4	the LDC bonds and the individual activity for
5	each bond for the year and then there's some
6	recaps of our finances. Pretty much all of
7	this information comes from our financial
8	audit or like subsidiary confirms that we
9	received.
10	Is there any questions on PARIS?
11	MR. BRAUN: My only question is and
12	I don't have the screen in front of me with
13	the financial statement this is now
14	finalized and dated?
15	LORI LaPONTE: Yes, it is. The audited
16	statements are on our website. They're on
17	letterhead and they're final dated.
18	MR. BRAUN: Thank you.
19	LORI LaPONTE: PARIS now, right now the
20	drafts of PARIS that I sent you say
21	unsubmitted. Once you approve it, it will say
22	submitted and we had notified the State that
23	we would be submitting this month. They had
24	given an extension through the end of June, we
25	asked for one additional month because we

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2	wanted to make sure the financials got
3	approved and they said that that's fine, just
4	note it and Lisa had sent a letter and we're
5	going to note it when we submit our annual
6	report in PARIS, the reason for the delay.
7	MR. BRAUN: Other questions?

16	the LDC had been up to 3,000 and the IDA
17	was up to 5,000 for a single signature and
18	what I'm suggesting is that we get them
19	aligned so that both the IDA and the LDC have
20	the authority for one signature up to \$5,000.
21	MR. BRAUN: So we need a resolution to
22	increase that to 5,000 at Empire Bank.
23	Somebody care to make that resolution?
24	MR. CALLAHAN: So moved.
25	MS. SCHEIDT: Second.
