14	MR. GRUCCI: I just got a question.
15	If I I'm wearing the earphones. If
16	I take them off and close my camera, does that
17	constitute the recusal or do I need to sign
18	off completely?
19	MS. EADERESTO: No, that's fine. You
20	can take your earphones off so you can't hear
21	and cut your video and don't watch. That's
22	fine.
23	MR. GRUCCI: Okay. That's what I'm
24	going to do then.
25	MR. BRAUN: And I will leave the room.

2	Lisa, back to you.
3	MS. MULLIGAN: Okay.
4	So the next item on the agenda is an
5	amended and restated authorizing resolution
6	for the Long Island Community Hospital
7	project.
8	Bill, do you want to give an overview
9	of what's why we're doing this resolution?
10	MR. WEIR: We've decided that one
11	series of bonds that we're refinancing, the
12	2006 IDA bonds, for a number of reasons need
13	to be refinanced on a taxable basis and not a
1 4	tax-exempt basis because some changes of uses
15	of some of those projects that were financed
16	back in '06.
17	Therefore, we're going to have two
18	series of bonds I'm sorry, was somebody
19	asking a question?
2 0	(Inaudible.)
21	MR. MIDDLETON: I don't think Fred's
22	muted. He left the room, but he's not muted.
23	MR. WEIR: So anyway, there are now
2 4	the original resolution from earlier in the
25	year just had all tax-exempt bonds and now we

2	will have one series of tax-exempt bonds and
3	one series of taxable bonds, so it's really
4	just a change of how we're treating one of the
5	series of bonds.
6	MR. TROTTA: Question:
7	What if Long Island Community Hospital
8	merges with Stony Brook, what then happens?
9	MR. WEIR: If well, it's not
10	technically a merger, it's going to be a
11	MR. TROTTA: Correct. I know.
12	MR. WEIR: It's an affiliation.
13	MR. TROTTA: Yup.
14	MR. WEIR: They will lease the hospital
15	to the actual building to Stony Brook
16	Medical Center and the employees will be under
17	a contract to operate the hospital on behalf
18	of Stony Brook Medical Center. The lease
19	payments will include an amount sufficient to
20	not only pay all the employees, but to pay the
21	debt service on these bonds and a couple of
22	other loans that are outstanding.
23	MR. TROTTA: Okay. So that doesn't
2 4	change anything from our perspective if that
25	happens with these bonds that we're talking

2	about today?
3	MR. WEIR: No. In fact, part of the
4	reason we have to refinance their existing
5	bonds is that that affiliation would have been
6	prohibited under the prior bonds the way the
7	covenants are structured, so while that
8	affiliation agreement has not been entered
9	into yet, we have added into our bond
10	documents as well as we've created a master
11	trust indenture for the hospital that
12	contemplates that there may be this
13	affiliation in the future and that will be a
14	permitted transaction.
15	MR. TROTTA: Okay. Very good, thank
16	you.
17	MR. WEIR: You're welcome.
18	MS. MULLIGAN: Did anyone have any
19	other questions?
20	(No response.)
21	MS. MULLIGAN: Do we have a motion?
22	MR. TROTTA: I'll make a motion.
23	MR. MIDDLETON: Second.
24	MS. MULLIGAN: I think Frank made the
25	most and Scott seconded it, is that what I
